



2010 Alberta Summer Games Receives Funding For Track Upgrades

Peace River, Alberta - Tuesday November 10, 2009 - A cheque presentation will be held at the 2010 Alberta Summer Games office in Peace River on Thursday, November 12, 2009 at 11:30 a.m. M.L.A. Frank Oberle will be presenting a cheque for \$49,418 towards track upgrades at Glenmary/TA Norris in Peace River. The funds are from the Community Facility Enhancement Program from the Alberta Lottery Fund.

With generous gift in kind support from Ruel Bros Contracting, Glen Armstrong Construction and Sok's Contracting, work on the track began this past October. With the CFEP funding confirmed and weather conditions more conducive to the type of work needed to complete the track, final construction will be completed in the spring. The track construction is being done to increase the track from six to eight lanes which is required for this level of competitive track and field.
